ANTON TRSTENJAK, PhD

Our school is named after the former pupil, a later famous Slovenian philosopher, anthropologist, psychologist and theologian Anton Trstenjak, PhD.

OUR SCHOOL

- Teaching takes place in the old and new building of the school.
- Students have lockers.
- Classes are equipped with ITC facilities: PCs, smart boards, projectors.
- Teachers can integrate 6 I pads into lessons.
- The computer room is equipped with 14 PCs and headphones.
- There are some special classes: for teaching household, technology, studies for special needs education.

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- A kitchen where lunches are prepared for school children and children of the kindergarten.
- One dining room for meals served at school.
- There are two kindergarten classes hosted in our school building.
- The gym is multi-purpose. It organizes classes, recreation and cultural events.
- School has a small library.





SCHOOL PROGRAMME

- A nine year compulsory school program is held in school for students aged from 6 to 15 in nine grades.
- The first six years as primary education, the final 3 years as lower secondary education.
- Our students study English as the 1st foreign language and German as the 2nd foreign language.





SCHOOL PROGRAMME

- There are three cycles of education with different set of compulsory subjects and teaching methods. The curriculum includes Slovenian Language, History, Geography, Mathematics, Technical Education, Arts, Physical Education, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and elective subjects.
- Other methods of working with children: morning care, afterschool classes, class discussion periods and days of activities (cultural, sports, technical, science days), extra-curricular activities for talented students, outdoor school, information technologies ...

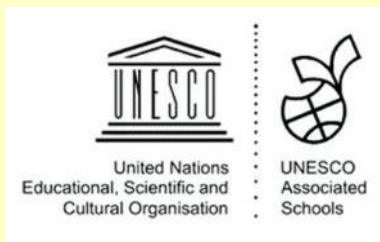
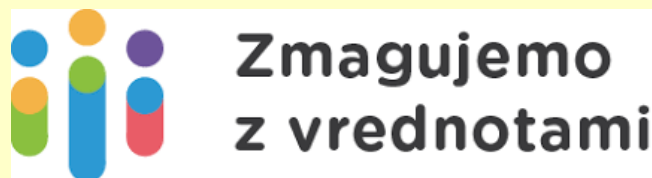
Students have the choice of around 30 different activities (puppets, sports, choirs, Lego and Fischer Technik, science, fairytales, drama, beekeeping etc).

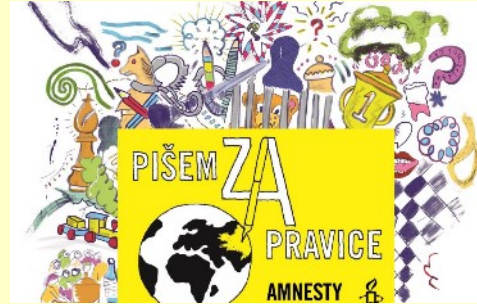




UNESCO school

Cultural school



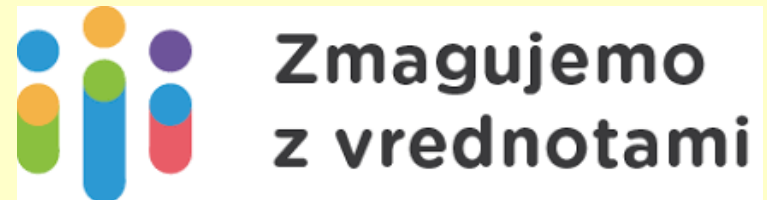
We are very proud of the title cultural school, which is reflected in various activities in singing, drama, puppetry and organizing events.

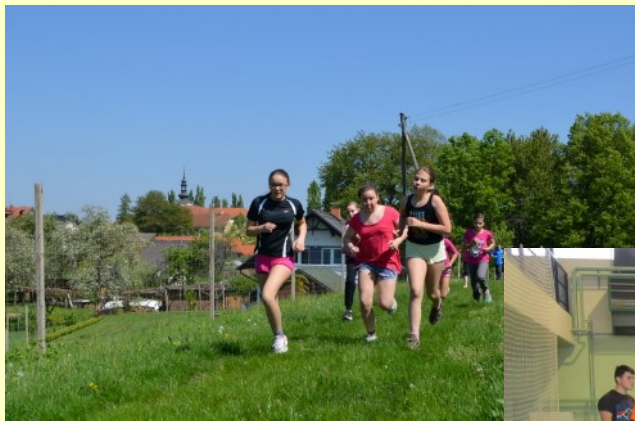
